Sound Of Perpetual Astonishment is a small independent label founded in Denmark in late 2006 by journalist and music writer Lars Kjær Dideriksen (author/editor of 'århus: nu' and former editor of Supertanker among other things). The music of SOPA is not centered around a certain genre or style – or even a geographical place. Instead it revolves around friendships drawing lines across the world united in the common love for music. So far the artists are located in Denmark, Belgium, Germany and Italy.

The purpose of Sound Of Perpetual Astonishment is to share sounds that have lots of personality and heart with the rest of the world. Sounds that might not get heard otherwise. A testing ground for new artists, sideprojects of more established artists and a playground for interesting collaborations. All pure homegrown and deeply personal music.

A limited number of copies of each will be made available for sale. They are individually handnumbered and prices are kept at a minimum.

Besides the first two releases by Nils Grøndahl of Under Byen and Marzipan Marzipan in January of 2007 there are a lot of other releases in the works from such artists as A.K. Hansn (Singvogel), Delay Lama (ex-Strumm), Girls Love Rallie (ex-My Friend George), 9, I Like This Wind and Resident Tourist. And that is not all. Plenty more great sounds are just waiting to see the light of day. Spoken word, punk, pop, noise, experimental and so forth. But let's keep that under wraps for now.
